Budget Update – Jason Tei

- Jason provided a presentation of this year's expenses and profits for each activity, PTC's expense percentages,
- Checking account balance is \$40,944.00
- If expenses remain even, surplus revenue at the end of the year will be \$3,613.64 (estimated) – possible to include more extracurricular activities?
- Hold forum in February to discuss and provide feedback on the expectations of the budget and desires for ways to use funds. Is this a good idea? Consensus is yes
- Possibly putting \$10,000 in a 12-month Certificate of Deposit (CD) and \$6,000 in a 6-month CD to gain interest on money that is currently sitting in checking.
 - Discussion: Penalties to pull out early would be loss in interest and possibly a blanket fee on principle.
 - Vote: Motion to invest \$20,000 as stated above (Christine Heyen). 2nd (Lyndsie Taylor). Motion passes.
